It will involve an exploration of the ways terrorism is defined in legal, policy, and research terms. Such questions as: what perspectives of international relations and conflict resolution theories best capture the phenomenon of terrorism in today's international environment - Francis Fukuyama's end of history, Samuel Huntington's clash of civilizations, or Thomas Friedman's impact of globalization? It will also cover issues of broad terrorist strategies and specific terrorist tactics.
