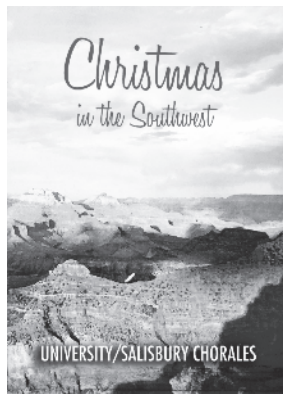

The Cultural Laureate Program (CLP)

How is my attendance at these events recorded?

Look for the sign! Look for the CLP representative at the entrance to the event to sign in. You are expected to stay and enjoy the entire event.* Your attendance at CLP events is tracked by SU's Office of Cultural Affairs; attend at least five selected events during the semester and you will become a Cultural Laureate.
