### CAPT. ROBERT HILL, JR., COMBAT VET, NAMED AS SCHOOL SECRETARY

Capt. Robert A. Hill, Jr., B-24 combat veteran, was named school secretary this week, succeeding Capt. Jack Drake, who transferred to Randolph Field. CWO Jerome Tengler was made assistant to Captain Hill.

Assigned here early in March, Captain Hill has been serving as assistant base operations officer. Mr. Tengler formerly was assigned as adjutant of the officer student detachment.

Captain Hill was commissioned in April, 1942, after completing his pilot training at Brooks Field, and went overseas in July, 1943. He was stationed in England and returned to the United States in November, 1944.

He was awarded the DFC and Air Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters for his combat service. He also wears the EAME ribbon with five battle stars.—Taken from a paper published in Fort Worth, Texas.
