OURCA is committed to supporting the scholarly efforts of all students at Salisbury University. Any student with an idea for a scholarly inquiry, or its different aspects including travel for gathering data, attendance or presentation at a conference, getting materials or access to databases, and other efforts can apply for financial support from OURCA.

Based on project requirements and proposed need, a maximum of \$500 will be awarded per student per semester. The information below will provide a basis for the provision of these funds.

Eligibility: Any current SU student, in good standing, is eligible for the grant. Students must have a faculty mentor overseeing their scholarly effort approve their application. The faculty mentor must be a full time employee and is responsible for the students' appropriate conduct of the research (i.e., obtaining IRB approval) or scholarly efforts (e.g., developing an idea).
