## Beginning the Internship

- ✓ Promptly complete the online form for payment.
- ✓ Welcome your intern and introduce them to students, staff and administration.
- ✓ Take your intern on a tour of the building.
- ✓ Provide your intern with a work space, curricular materials, important school information, procedures and expectations.
- ✓ Share school/team calendar with your intern so they can become active in school happenings.
- ✓ Share your goals for the internship and ask your intern to do the same.
- ✓ Decide together what your mode and frequency of communication will be throughout the internship.
- ✓ Plan for how you will reflect on lessons together and provide feedback for your intern.
- ✓ Ask your intern to share seminar, edTPA and certification requirements with you.
- ✓ Establish a collaborative relationship with the SU internship supervisor.

## At the Middle of the Internship

- ✓ Complete the intern mid-evaluation form in [Watermark/SL&L](#).
  - Be sure to click "Submit" when finished to complete the process.
- ✓ Meet with your intern and the internship supervisor to share the evaluation and set goals for the remainder of the internship experience.

## Ending the Internship

- ✓ Complete the intern final evaluation in [Watermark/SL&L](#).
  - Be sure to click "Submit" when finished to complete it.
- ✓ Meet with your intern and the internship supervisor to share evaluations forms to bring the internship to a close.

## Co-Teaching with Your Intern

- ✓ Collaborate with your intern in lesson planning, delivery and assessment of student learning.
- ✓ Implement a variety of co-teaching strategies within the co-teaching models.
  - One Teach, One Observe
  - One Teach, One Assist
  - Parallel Teaching
  - Station Teaching
  - Alternative Teaching
  - Team Teaching

- ✓ Provide scaffolding so that your intern is able to shift into the lead role in planning and instruction for a significant amount of time.
