Mission

Salisbury University is a premier comprehensive Maryland public university offering excellent, affordable education in undergraduate liberal arts, sciences, business, nursing, health sciences, social work, and education and applied master's and doctoral programs. Our highest purpose is to empower our students with the knowledge, skills, and core values that contribute to active citizenship, gainful employment, and lifelong learning in a democratic society and interdependent world.

Salisbury University cultivates and sustains a superior learning community where students, faculty, and staff are viewed as learners, teachers/scholars, and facilitators, and where a commitment to excellence and openness to a broad array of ideas and perspectives are central to all aspects of University life. Our learning community is student-centered. Students learn from professional educators in small classroom settings, faculty and professional staff serve as academic advisors, and virtually every student has an opportunity to undertake research or experiential learning with a faculty mentor. Through our privately endowed Schools and Honors College, and the College of Health and Human Services, we foster an environment where individuals prepare for career and life, including their social, physical, occupational, emotional, and intellectual well-being.

The University recruits exceptional and diverse faculty, staff, and undergraduate and graduate students from across Maryland and the United States and from around the world, supporting all members of the University community as they work together to achieve institutional goals and vision. Believing that learning and service are vital components of civic life, Salisbury University actively contributes to the local Eastern Shore community and the educational, economic, cultural, and social needs of our State and nation.

VALUES

The core values of Salisbury University are excellence, student centeredness, learning, community, civic engagement, and diversity and inclusion. We believe these values must be lived and experienced as integral to everyday campus life so that students make the connection between what they learn and how they live. The goals and objectives of our strategic, academic, facilities, and enrollment plans, as well as our fiscal commitments, reflect our fundamental values. In addition to these principal values, the University embraces, through its shared governance bodies, the long-honored tradition of honesty and mutual regard that is and should be a defining characteristic of higher education.



MACE

The University mace was created for the 1997 inauguration of William C. Merwin as seventh president. Clinton G. Bradway (Class of 1956) designed and donated the mace that is used at all official academic ceremonies.

The mace, originally a medieval weapon of war, has evolved into an institutional emblem of authority and symbol of office. This symbolic item is composed of a mahogany staff adorned with pewter rings, each engraved with the name and term of office of each of the University's presidents since its founding in 1925.

The head or orb has four flat, oval surfaces: one is overlaid with a 3-inch replica of the University seal; its opposite side features the Holloway Hall bell tower, the University's most enduring landmark; the surface of a third side reflects the evolution of the University's name; and the fourth side lists the University's schools and colleges: Franklin P. Perdue School of Business, Richard A. Henson School of Science and Technology, Charles R. and Martha N. Fulton School of Liberal Arts, Samuel W. and Marilyn C. Seidel School of Education, Glenda Chatham and Robert G. Clarke Honors College, and College of Health and Human Services.

Crowning the mace is a golden Sea Gull, symbolizing the University's long and distinguished varsity athletics programs. Eight wooden spikes, reminiscent of its medieval counterpart, are positioned just beneath and above the mace's head. These were crafted from a historic linden tree planted in front of Holloway Hall in 1925 and felled by a storm in 1995.



A symbol of the Salisbury University Office of the President, the medallion is worn by the President during ceremonial occasions. The original medallion was commissioned upon the 1997 inauguration of William C. Merwin as the seventh president of the University. Today's medallion is made from gold-plated brass and hangs from a golden chain. It incorporates the University seal at its center surrounded by a band engraved with the President's name.

SEAL

Salisbury's first president Dr. William J. Holloway organized a design contest for art students in 1927 to create a special seal for the school. Of the five designs submitted, the one drawn by Grace Hallam was selected.

Used without changes (except the institution's name), the seal is carefully composed of images unique to the school, as described at the time of its adoption:

"The loblolly pine is characteristic of the Eastern Shore; the sailboat represents the fishing industry; the plow and farm demonstrate agricultural interests; the strawberry bed in the lower left foreground represents a leading industry of the Eastern Shore; the sun at its zenith signifies the educational service that is hoped the school will render; the Maryland shield signifies that the school is a Maryland institution."



Academic Regalia

The traditional caps and gowns worn by students and faculty in the academic procession have been the historic costume of scholars since medieval times. Because many scholars of that period were members of monastic orders, the academic costume resembles ecclesiastical dress.

A uniform code for academic costumes was drafted by an intercollegiate commission in 1893 and has since been adopted by the majority of colleges and universities in the United States. Each of the three academic degrees – bachelor's, master's, and doctoral – has its own distinctive gown and hood. The gown representing the bachelor's degree is distinguished by its long, pointed sleeve. The master's gown has a longer, narrow closed sleeve, extending below the knee; the arm is passed through a slit at the elbow. In contrast, the doctor's gown has a full, bell-shaped sleeve with three bars of velvet. The opening of this gown is faced with wide velvet bands, which may be black or of a color indicating the general field of learning of the wearer – for example, dark blue for philosophy, green for medicine, purple for law, and light blue for education.

The most colorful and distinctive item of the academic costume is the hood, which passes around the neck and extends down the back. The colors of the silk lining exposed in the center of the hood are those of the college or university which conferred the degree.



GRADUATION WITH LATIN HONORS

Undergraduate students must complete a minimum of 56 graded hours of coursework at Salisbury University, in which at least 30 hours of 300/400-level courses are completed with grades of A, B or C. In addition, students must have minimum Salisbury University grade point averages as follows:

CUM LAUDE - 3.50 MAGNA CUM LAUDE - 3.70 SUMMA CUM LAUDE - 3.90

Students completing a second bachelor's degree will be eligible to graduate with honors only if they meet all graduation with honors criteria using credits earned after their prior graduation.

GRADUATION WITH UNIVERSITY HONORS

Undergraduate students graduating with University Honors from the Clarke Honors College have completed at least 21 hours of honors coursework and have completed a Research/Creative Project or a Senior Honors Thesis. A minimum grade point average of 3.30 is also required.

Recognition of graduates who will achieve Latin and University Honors is tentative pending certification of all graduation requirements.
