Reading Specialist Program and who meet the requirement of 27 months of satisfactory teaching performance will be eligible for the Reading Specialist certificate. However, it is the responsibility of the candidate to understand and fulfill all state requirements and to make application to the state for certification. Candidates in states other than Maryland should consult with their state Department of Education to determine specific certification requirements.
- Also, candidates are expected to complete a professional portfolio throughout the
 program, demonstrating their achievement of all required competencies. The portfolio
 should contain artifacts demonstrating the knowledge, skills, and attitudes of reading
 professionals, as well as reflective analysis of those artifacts and the learning
 experiences that led to their development.

Advisement for the program is available from the Literacy Studies Department.
