Updates

- The Center for Student Achievement works with undergraduate students in four main ways –
 Supplemental Instruction through scheduled, out-of-class group study sessions; tutoring through
 one-on-one or small group support; Success Coaching through collaborative work on succeeding
 academically; and the GENL 103 course that introduces students to study strategies and campus
 resources.
- Data shows that students who utilize CSA's resources earn higher grades, persist at a higher rate, and graduate at a higher rate than those students who do not participate.
