It All Starts With The FAFSA

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid FAFSA is an application you need to fill out every year so that you can be considered for federal student aid, including federal grants, loans and the work-study program and institutional need-based aid.

SU Has Scholarships Too

- When you submit your official transcripts and test scores when applying to SU, you are automatically considered for merit-based scholarships.
- As soon as you are admitted, you are eligible for some SU scholarships starting December 1, complete an application for scholarships that are tailored to majors, interests and backgrounds.
- Some have a financial need requirement, so you'll still need to fill out the FAFSA for consideration for those. SU offered more than a \$1 million in scholarships to our students last year.
